Upon entering the park, you can choose from your favourite ribber, grab a beverage of your choice and sit with your friends and family anywhere in the park. Seated areas are available, or you are welcome to bring your own chair and blanket.

The Port Moody Open Road Lexus VIP Zone is back bigger and better than ever. Seating is expanded. Guests receive individualized table service with options from Rusty's BBQ in addition to vegetarian choices. There are three seatings per day during the event.
